### **DPW on Patrol**

is a Crime Prevention Program designed to allow Public Works employees to report suspicious or unusual activity directly to the Police Department. All Public Works Personnel are equipped with portable radios which allow employees to quickly contact police and report accidents or crimes in progress. Public Works employees are well acquainted with the Township, and are qualified to notice anything out of the ordinary. The Public Works on Patrol Program is another example of Township agencies working together for the well being of the community.



### **Pothole Patrol**

Come across any potholes lately? Is the road bumpier than it used to be? The Department of Public Works needs your help in locating potholes and other dangerous cracks in the street. "If we don't know they're out there, we can't fix them,"

To report a pothole no matter how small or seemingly insignificant call the Township's Pothole Hotline at (908) 686-1922.

If the pothole is on our turf, workers from DPW will try to repair it within 48 hours on weekdays. For projects that require more than 48 hours to fix, DPW will develop an "action plan." If the repair is the responsibility of another agency such as utility, state, county roads, DPW will notify that agency. When you call, please give the potholes nearest street address and cross-street.
