Snow removal on sidewalk

Town Ordinance states that owners or occupants of property with sidewalks bordering on any street are required to remove snow and ice from sidewalks ten (24) hours after snow ceases to fall.

- Please make a path of at least four (4) feet in width and also clear ramps at corners that abut your property.
- Complaints can be made to Department of Public Works if snow/ice is not cleared 24 hours after snow ceases. Department of Public Works can be reached at (908) 686-1922.
- Department of Public Works will refer complaint to the enforcing agency which is the Code Enforcement Division.
- The fine for failing to comply with the city's sidewalk snow removal ordinance is One hundred and fifty dollars (\$150.00) per day.
- Even if you are on vacation or are a landlord it is still your responsibility as the property owner to ensure that your sidewalks are cleared.

Placing or throwing Snow in Streets is Illegal

The Uniform Traffic Code states: A person shall not deposit, or cause to be deposited, throw snow, ice, or slush on any roadway or highway.
