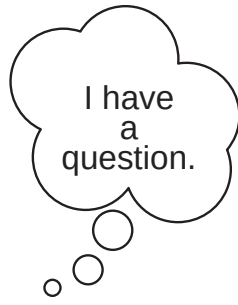

I want to borrow movies, music, eAudiobooks, eBooks, comics and TV shows for my computer, tablet, or phone or TV!

hoopla

With hoopla and a valid library card, you can borrow, instantly stream, and download dynamic content via hoopla's mobile app or hoopladigital.com.

How do I sign up? Download the free Hoopla app from your device's app store. Enter your email and create a password.

Click next and choose Union Public Library. Enter your library card number, without spaces, and your pin which is usually the last four digits of your phone number on your library account.

Once registered, you can browse by format, title, author and more. After borrowing a title, tap "Download to your device" right below the play/read button. When fully downloaded, you can access the title without internet connection.

You can also access Hoopla from a web browser. Go to uplnj.org and click on 24/7 Digital Library. Select hoopla and "Get Started Today". Create an account using the steps above.

eBooks and eAudiobooks can be borrowed for 21 days. Music can be borrowed for 7 days. Videos can be borrowed for 3 days. There is a total monthly limit of 4 items borrowed per month. Items will automatically delete when due.
