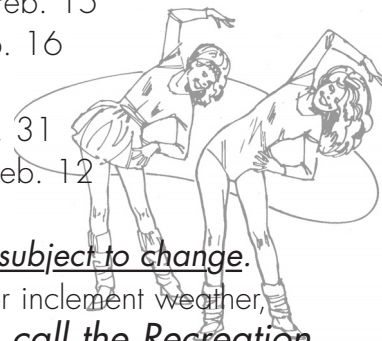
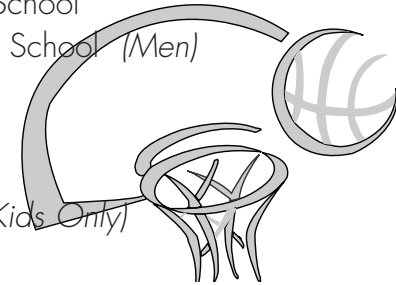

A second session will begin in January.

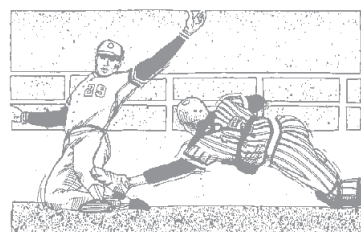
