Mr. Terrezza explained to her that he has been very busy with negotiations with the PBA and will call her in the next few days.

Roxanne Ciampi, Beechwood Avenue, stated that she did not receive a Reverse 911 call with the latest snowstorm. Mr. Terrezza explained that they did go out with the second storm.

Mrs. Ciampi commended the Department of Public Works on the great job they did during the snowstorm.

Mrs. Ciampi questioned what the percentage increases were for Municipal Employees. Mr. Terrezza gave the percentages that were agreed to in the new contracts. Mrs. Ciampi also requested exact figures. Mr. Terrezza stated that at this time only the ranges were available in the salary ordinance.

Mrs. Ciampi questioned items # 11 and #17 on the agenda, Mr. Bradley responded to her questions.

Mrs. Ciampi stated that she was happy all the Unions came to an agreement.

Allan Hodapp, Orange Avenue, questioned Item #30 on the agenda. Mr.

Manzella responded.

Charles Donnelly, Reinhold Terrace, commended the Department of Public Works on the outstanding job they did during the recent snowstorm.

Mr. Donnelly questioned the Committee as to why West Chestnut Street is being paved and not others streets that need it more. Mr. Terrezza advised him that West Chestnut Street is a County Road and he must address his issue with the County. Mr. Terrezza read him a list of all the streets to be paved and many of the streets are the ones Mr. Donnelly was concerned about.

There being no further business presented, the Township Committee on motion of Mr. Florio, seconded by Mr. People, and carried, adjourned the meeting, the time being 8:34 P.M.
