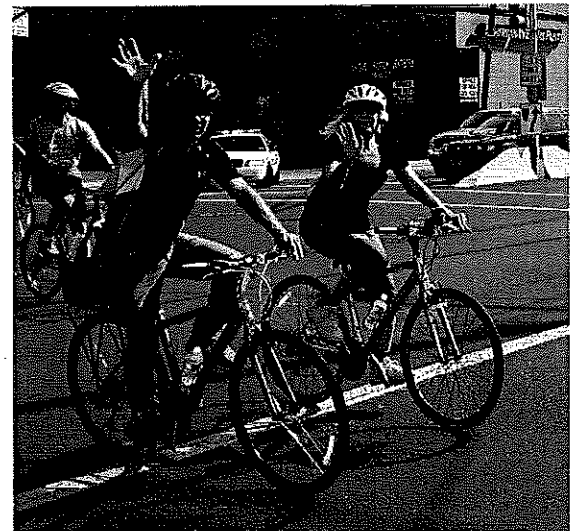

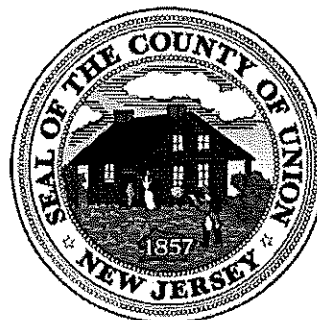
Important:
