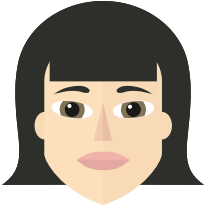

Go to uplnj.org and click on 24/7 Digital Library. Click education on the sidebar to the left and then on LearningExpress Library.
