GENERAL RULES:

Poster entries must provide a **positive message** and focus on Autism Awareness.

Use only 11" x 17" size paper

Must be a student's ORIGINAL artwork.

NO glue; NO glitter; NO attachments; NO signatures on front of posters!

NO syndicated, copyrighted, or clipart images!

Use of high contrast and bright colors is allowed

The phrase "Autism Awareness Month" may be incorporated into the design but it is not mandatory

Participants must put their full name, homeroom and grade on the reverse side of the poster.

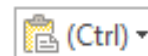
NO computer-aided entries!

Poster paper and rules can be picked up in the Guidance Department

All posters must be completed and submitted to the Guidance Department by April 12th, 2019.

Posters will be picked up by a member of the ADA Committee on April 15th, 2019.

The members of the ADA Committee and [Jazz'd Up for Autism](#) attendees will judge all posters and choose a winner.



The winning poster will be used as an informative piece for our town wide Autism Awareness campaign during the month of April 2020.

THEME:
