



Union's Got Talent 2021 Virtual Show Rules

- The show is open to contestants of any age that, reside, work or attend a Township of Union School.
- A group with multiple performers must have at least one member who is from the town.
- All contestants must fill out the online UGT Virtual Show Application via **uniontownship.com** and submit their entry video. All applications and videos must be prerecorded and submitted by February 26th at 12pm.
- Talents may include (*but not limited to*) singing, dancing, instrumental music, skits, magic, comedy, martial arts, juggling, NO LIP-SYNCHING.
- Singing auditions can be acapella or Karaoke style.
- **Absolutely no profanity or insensitive subject matter will be permitted!**
- Costumes must be appropriate for all age groups. This is a community event.
- Weekly zoom conferences with our judges will be recorded at the beginning of the week; please try to make yourself available to join (not necessary).
- New video submissions will be needed if the contestant moves past the entry round into the semi-finals and then to the final.

Video Guidelines

- All video submissions must be filmed horizontally; no vertical recordings will be accepted.
- The recommended length for all videos is a minimum of 3-minutes to a 5-minute maximum. Videos exceeding 5 minutes will be not accepted.
- If filming from a laptop, make sure you are looking into the camera and not at yourself on the screen
- Bright or natural light is best; avoid backlight.
- Be mindful of your surroundings. We recommend a plain, solid background that is free of objects and clutter.
